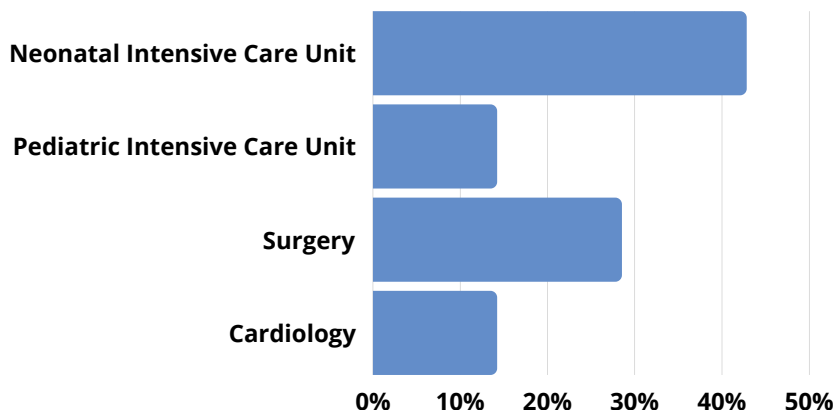
### MESSAGE FROM RMHCCV

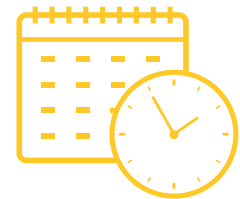

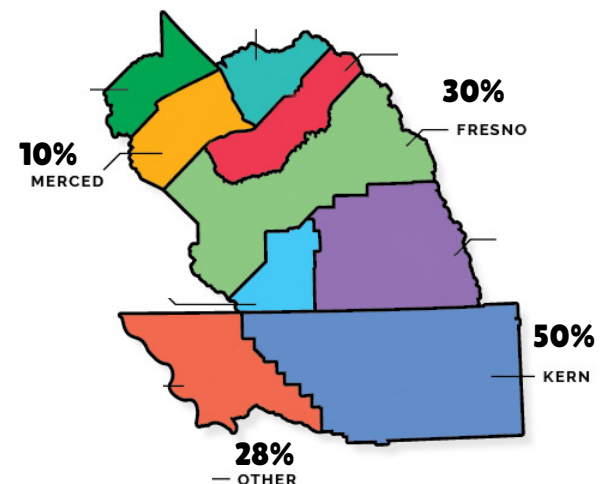

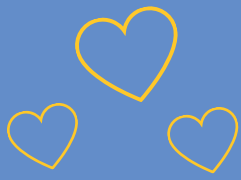

## NEW TOILETS AND KITCHEN ACCESSORIES

With the support of Mr. Rooter Plumbing, we had general plumbing inspections done in every room of the House. The staff at Mr. Rooter Plumbing Service donated their time and replaced multiple toilets and sinks throughout the house. We also purchased four new air fryers for each kitchen. These new appliances will allow our guest families to cook up a quick and easy meal. In addition to general plumbing improvements, new garbage disposals were purchased and installed in each kitchen. This small but major update will allow all RMHCCV kitchens to continue to operate properly and safely.
