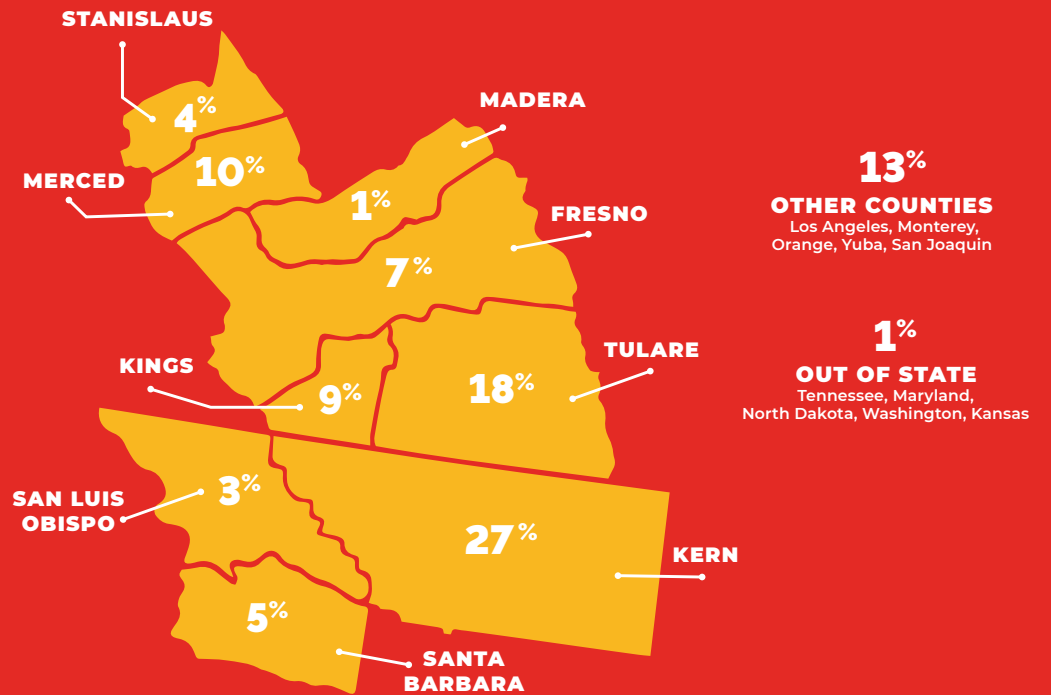

At night, this space transforms into the Spare Room, providing temporary housing for families on our waiting list.

Introduced in 2016, the Hotels From the Heart Program extends our reach to accommodate families in need, providing them with a place to stay the night before surgery, procedure, or appointment (one-two night stay) so they do not have to travel the day of surgery. Partnering with esteemed hotels like Hyatt Place, Sonesta Suites, and TownePlace Suites in Fresno, we can place families in a hotel room until space becomes available at our House. This initiative ensures that no family faces their journey alone.

Family Support

In 2024, RMHC Central Valley launched Family Support Services in partnership with Alliant International University, bringing on-site mental health care to families for the first time. Graduate-level psychology students from Alliant, supervised by licensed professionals, now offer counseling and emotional support to families facing the stress of a hospitalized child. This compassionate initiative not only strengthens our support system, but also provides valuable training for future mental health professionals. We're proud to be part of this meaningful, healing-centered collaboration.

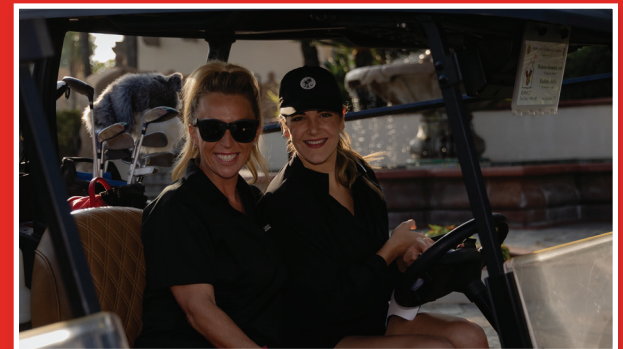

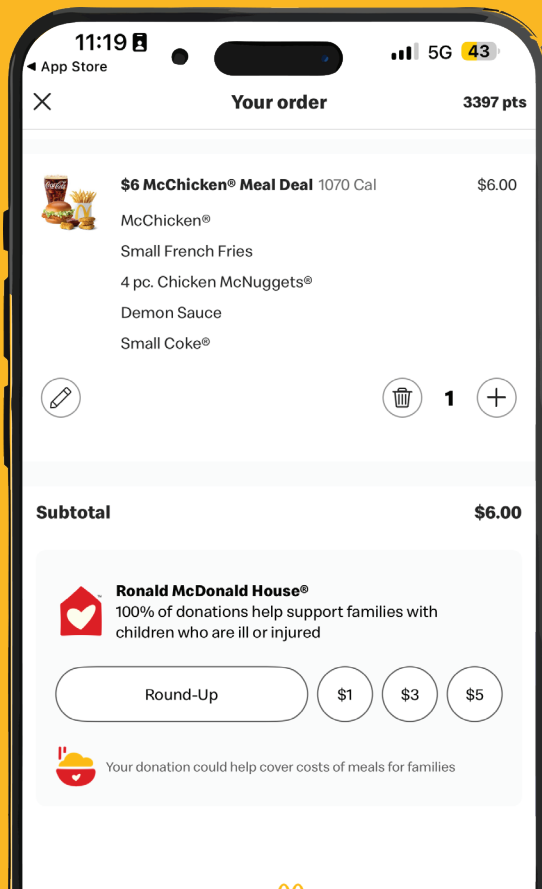
